Latinx is a recently adopted gender-neutral alternative to Latina or Latino. It is a term used to describe a diverse group of people who have roots in Latin America.

The date of September 15 is significant, as it is the anniversary of independence for Latin American countries Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. In addition, M exico and Chile celebrate their independence days on Sept. 16 and 18, respectively.

The observation started in 1968 as Hispanic Heritage Week under President Lyndon Johnson, and was expanded by President Ronald Reagan in 1988 to cover a 30-day period starting on Sept. 15 and ending on Oct. 15.
