The fourth Design Advisory Group (DAG) opened with comments on the McDaniel (MHS) and Lincoln (LHS) HS tours. The design team shared an overview for the planned upgrades at the Cleveland Stadium site. The design team then shared updates on the development of the exterior design. The update included an analysis of images that were shared at DAG 03 and an analysis of the features of the existing building. The design team is using a metaphor to describe the building: a geode. The outer edges will be rougher, with materials and windows that represent a more civic context. The inner courtyard faces will be smoother and have more opportunities for color.
